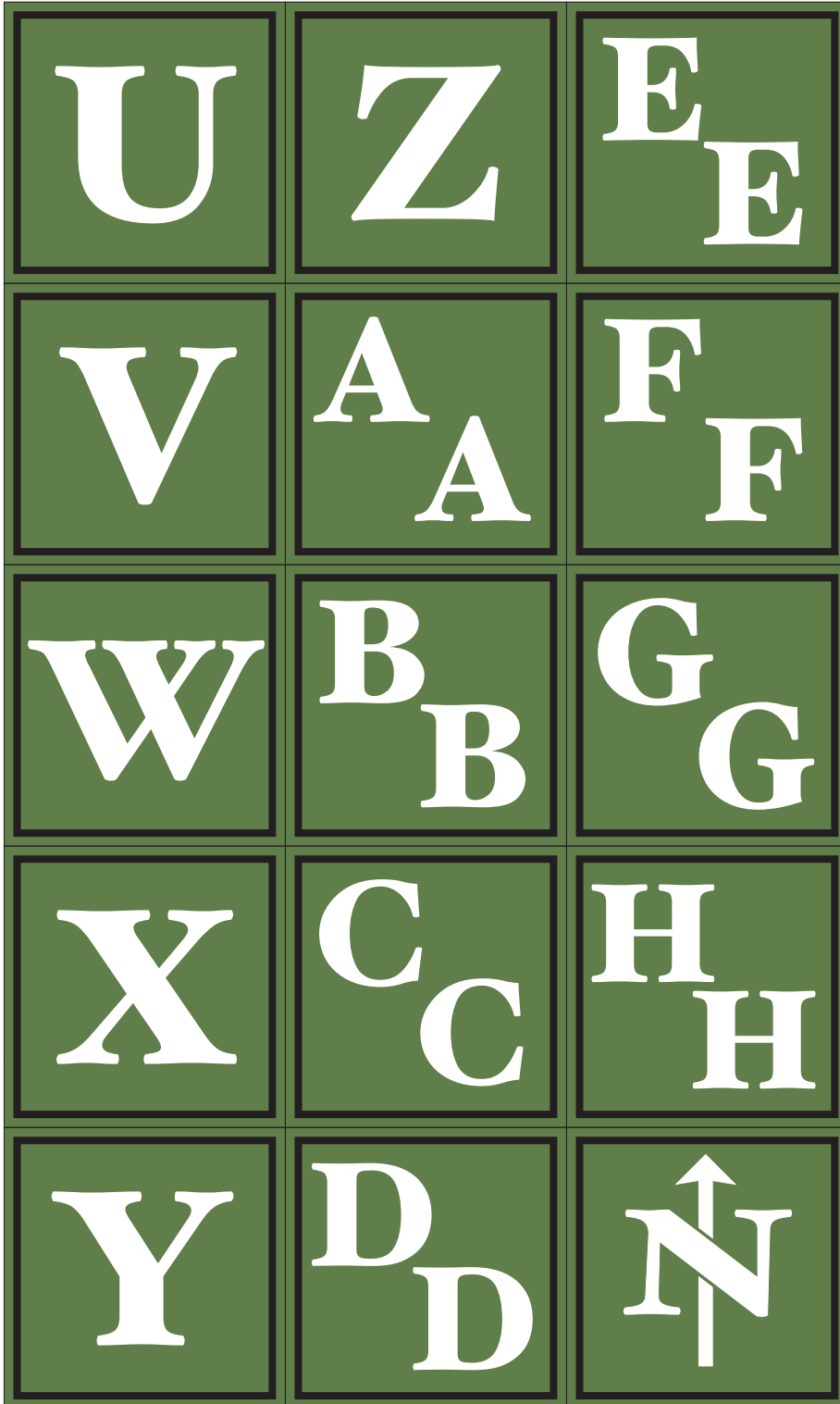

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Printout in full color
2. Spray printout with varnish or a clear coat protection.
3. Let dry.
4. Spray glue printout onto cardstock for best results. Cardboard: use a matting board or an illustration board; be sure to spray glue both the back of your printout and the cardboard surface, and then wait 3 minutes.
5. Carefully place the printout onto the cardboard and rub the printout down to ensure a good bond.
6. Using a steel ruler and a sharp knife, cut the number/ letters out.

NOTE: Varnish coating helps to extend the life of your card markers, and will, if using an inkjet printouts, make your printouts water resistant.
